Outside Play: Please Read

Now that we have snow all the children are even more excited about going outside to play. In order to make it as easy for all of us as possible, the following are guidelines which we will follow when going outside in the winter:

- It seems as though Mondays are super busy days, so we will **NOT** be going outside on **Mondays**. You do not need to worry about bringing boots or snow pants to preschool on Mondays.
- We **will** plan to go outside on **Wednesdays** and **Fridays**. It will always depend on our daily schedule but will try our best.
